



Online Safety and Filtering Policy

POLICY STATEMENT

Munchkin Sports Ltd is committed to safeguarding children from online harm, including exposure to inappropriate content, cyberbullying, misinformation, digital grooming and emerging AI-generated risks such as deepfakes and nudification. Online safety is a core safeguarding responsibility and forms part of our whole organisation approach to child protection.

KEY MEASURES

- All devices used during sessions are subject to age-appropriate filtering and monitoring systems that meet DFE and IWF standards and are reviewed at least once every year, in line with the statutory requirements.
- Staff receive annual training on emerging online risks, including disinformation, grooming, and digital radicalisation.
- Children are supervised during any online activity and taught basic digital safety principles.
- Any online safety concern is treated as a safeguarding issue and reported via standard procedures.
- Staff must not communicate with children via personal devices or social media platforms.
- Parents are provided with guidance on supporting online safety at home if required.

We are committed to reviewing our policy and good practice annually.
